Types of HIV Treatments

Stem-cell based gene therapy
A genetically engineered hematopoietic stem cell transplant with anti-HIV genes

Broadly neutralizing antibodies
A type of antibody that works to kill most of the HIV variants, administered through a vaccine

Latency reversal
A strategy that involves drugs that reactivate HIV in cells then the immune system targets and kills those cells


